## **INSTRUCTIONS**


To assist your Assessment, please:

- Have someone else take these photos.
- ✓ Take photos from abdominal level.
- Ensure photos are clear and in focus
- ✓ Take the photos in good lighting with minimal shadows on the face.
- Take photos in front of a plain wall.
- Stand naturally, no arching back or pushing out stomach.
- ☑ Bra can be worn. If worn, your underpants should be loose and pushed down below pubic line. This will help to show the amount of excess skin at the hips and between belly button and pubic area.


## **PHOTOS WE REQUIRE**



**FRONT**Arms cross over chest.
Not obstructing view of abdominal area.



**BACK**Arms down and in front of body.



**LEFT and RIGHT**Arms cross over chest. Not obstructing view of abdominal area.
