- As a baseline to measure your results



INSTRUCTIONS

To assist your Assessment, please:

- Have someone else take the photos
- Ensure photos are clear and in focus
- ✓ Take the photos in good lighting with minimal shadows on the body.
- Take photos in front of a plain wall.
- ✓ Take photos in a standing position.
- Photos should show upper neck to lower hips.
- Stand naturally do not push out chest
- Remove all upper garments
- Photos must be taken from nipple height.

LEFT and RIGHTArms Down and Slightly Back






LEFT and RIGHT at 45° ANGLE Arms Down and Slightly Back
