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## INTRODUCTION

Ear Pinning, or Otoplasty, is the surgical reshaping of the ears. Performed on both adults and children, the procedure can change the angle of prominent ears, reduce ear asymmetries, and repair congenital abnormalities.

While prime candidates for Ear Pinning are children aged between 4 and 14 years old (i.e. those with soft and easy to mould cartilage), adult Ear Pinning surgeries are performed with great success. The procedure can address a range of concerns, including:

- Protruding ears
- ☑ Oversized ears
- ☑ Large or stretched earlobes
- ☑ Constricted ears (cupped/lop ears)
- Stahl's Ear Deformity (extra crease in the cartilage)
- 🗹 Earlobe volume loss

In cases of asymmetry (when one ear protrudes differently to the other), both ears will still be addressed. This is to ensure balance and prevent the need for future surgical revisions.

Individuals seek this procedure to reshape ear contours, correct protrusion, and achieve a harmonious facial balance.

#### **ENQUIRY & ASSESSMENT**

#### YOUR SURGERY | 1 hour

Ear Pinning surgery takes approximately 1 hour. During which time, clients are placed under general anaesthesia.

### WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER YOUR PROCEDURE

Recovery periods vary from person to person; however, we advise clients to allow 6 weeks for post-surgery recovery.



#### HOSPITAL STAY | Half Day - Overnight

In Australia, Ear Pinning is typically regarded as day surgery. So, assuming good general health, clients can leave hospital 2 to 3 hours after they wake. Clients undergoing the procedure in Thailand are required to have a short hospital stay (usually overnight).



#### REST TIME | 2 Weeks

The results of an Ear Pinning procedure are visible immediately and downtime is minimal. Bruising will emerge in the first few days. Pain medication can be used to alleviate discomfort. To aid recovery:

- Post-operative head band must be worn for 10 to 12 days.
- Clients are required to sleep on their back and avoid washing their hair with shampoo for the first week.
- Clients can generally resume work or school after 1 2 weeks.



#### RECOVERY TIME | 2 - 3 Weeks

Light exercise can resume after 3 weeks, however contact sports, swimming and strenuous exercise should be avoided for 6 weeks. In some cases, nerve endings may be cut during the procedure. When this occurs, clients will experience itchy sensations as the nerves regenerate. Care must be taken to not scratch the ears as this could disrupt recovery.



#### SETTLING PERIOD | 4 - 6 Weeks

Scars are thin and unnoticeable and, once swelling and bruising subsides from 4 weeks onwards, clients can enjoy the benefits of their procedure without others knowing they had it done.

### PLANNING YOUR PROCEDURE

Ear Pinning procedures typically address congenital issues—concerns that have been with clients since birth. A unique approach is required for each procedure and there are a range of considerations to keep in mind during the planning process.

The first of these is the client's age. Around the age of 14, the ears are fully grown. This means that, from this point on, the cartilage is harder. While not impossible to work with, this will impact the approach a surgeon takes. Other considerations include:

- Degree of protrusion
- Asymmetries
- Amount of excess skin and cartilage

Clients presenting with Cupped Ears, Lopped Ears, or Stahl's Ear Deformity can have these issues addressed simultaneously.

# EAR PINNING TECHNIQUES

There are 2 main Ear Pinning techniques used:

- Stitch Otoplasty
- Cartilage Scoring

These can be performed on their own or in conjunction with each other, as the case requires.

#### STITCH OTOPLASTY

The Stitch Otoplasty technique involves a small incision at the back of the ear. Excess skin and cartilage are removed before the remaining cartilage is repositioned to draw the ear closer to the head. Internal sutures are used to keep the cartilage in its new position and external sutures tighten the skin over the incision.

#### CARTILAGE SCORING

Cartilage Scoring starts with the same incision as a Stitch Otoplasty. Once open, Surgeons make a cut just inside the cartilage. The skin will then be peeled off the of the front of the cartilage so that score marks can be made—these enable the cartilage to bend back towards the head naturally before the incision site is closed.

#### EAR-STITCH TECHNIQUE

Occasionally, a third technique can be used. Known as the 'Ear-Stitch' technique, this will see stitches placed on the back of the ear, on the upper, middle, and lower third. The ears are physically drawn back toward the head and no incisions are required. While less invasive, this technique is not suitable for all clients. Your Plastic Surgeon will advise if this is an option for you.

## POTENTIAL RISKS TO CONSIDER

While you can rest assured that you'll be in the most capable surgical hands throughout your CosMediTour Rhinoplasty, there are potential risks to consider with all forms of surgery.

Our expert Plastic Surgeons take the utmost care to minimise the occurrence of surgical complications & work out of hospitals renowned for their high quality & practice standards. Most of the following possible risks & complications are ones associated with all surgeries.

### **RISKS & POSSIBLE COMPLICATIONS**

- Surgical risks (infections, bleeding, allergic reactions to medical materials)
- Nausea (temporary from anaesthetic)
- Haematoma (collection of blood)
- Pain, bruising and swelling
- Scarring (standard or Keloid lumpy, inflamed, and itchy)
- Numbness, tightness, and ear sensitivity
- Ulcers (near incision site)
- Asymmetry
- Re-protrusion (from broken sutures)
- Need for revisional surgery
